

MEET OUR GRADUATES

Monash graduates have gone on to rewarding and diverse careers around the world. From doctors and scientists to activists and community leaders, they are making their mark in their chosen fields.

Joel Neoh is best known as the founder of Groupon Malaysia and Fave. He is also the co-founder of REV Asia, Malaysia's largest digital media group. In 2013, he was recognised with the Malaysian Service Medal by the Prime Minister and named one of Asia's Top 10 entrepreneurs and Young Global Leader by the World Economic Forum.



Bryan Loo sparked the bubble tea's surge in popularity when he brought the Cha Time franchise to Malaysia. He is the founder, CEO and Managing Director of Loob Holding Sdn Bhd. His flagship brand Tealive operates over 500 outlets globally.

BUSINESS AND TECHNOLOGY

Tan Sri Dato' Dr Abu Bakar Suleiman is Malaysia's former Director General of Health. He most notably developed Hospital Kuala Lumpur's nephrology, dialysis and renal transplantation services, and introduced a network of dialysis centers across Malaysia. He's currently the Chairman of IHH Healthcare, Asia's largest private healthcare group, and President of IMU Group.

Professor Dato' Dr Adeeba Kamarulzaman dedicated her life's work to the prevention, treatment and research of infectious diseases and HIV/AIDS. She is the Chair of the Malaysian AIDS Foundation, Co-Chair of the WHO Science Council and Commissioner for the Global Commission on Drug Policy. She received the Merdeka Award in 2008 and Mahathir Science Award in 2007. In 2023, she was appointed the President and Pro Vice-Chancellor of Monash University Malaysia.

Dato' Dr Rozali Wathooth is one of Malaysia's pioneering cardiothoracic surgeons. He founded the country's first open-heart unit at Hospital Kuala Lumpur in 1982, where the first open-heart surgery was performed in April and the first coronary artery bypass in October. He went on to start the country's first private open-heart unit at Subang Jaya Medical Centre.

HEALTH AND EDUCATION

Safaath Ahmed Zahir is the Communication Strategist for the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Maldives and a leading women's rights activist. She is the founder of Women and Democracy and co-founder of Women on Boards. She was named one of Forbes' 30 Under 30 in Asia and recognised by the United Nations for her work in 2017, and presented with the Queen's Young Leaders Award in 2016.



Tan Sri Hamidon Ali is the former Ambassador of Malaysia to the United Nations and the first Malaysian to be appointed President of the United Nations Economic and Social Council.

YB Tuan Lim Guan Eng is a current member of the Parliament and former Minister of Finance and Chief Minister of Penang.

Kimberly Wan is a figure skater and national ice hockey player. She is the Malaysia Book of Records holder for the 'Youngest female to achieve the highest skating level in Malaysia' and was the first Malaysian linesman to officiate the Women's Challenge Cup of Asia tournament in 2013.



Jasmine Suraya Chin is an actress and television host best known for her work in the 2018 Malaysian action film PASKAL.



Nana Al Haleq is a celebrity fitness coach and TV host of several fitness programs.


Cost of living



- PTE (Academic) – Overall score of 58 with no Communicative Skills lower than 50. www.pearsonpte.com

- CAE/CPE/Cambridge Linguaskill General – Minimum overall score of 176 with no skill score lower than 169. www.cambridgeenglish.org
- Monash English Bridging (selected courses)

In order for the above English Proficiency tests to be considered they must be taken within 36 months prior to the course commencement date.

Note: Higher scores are required for the Bachelor of Human Nutrition and the Bachelor of Medical Science and Doctor of Medicine.
